Responsible and secure investments

- **Actively seek grants and subsidies** (State, region, CeA, Europe, etc.)
- **Securing financing before starting any project**
- Consult residents for any project over €150,000
- Public-Private Partnerships
- Use borrowing responsibly, especially as existing loans come to an end during the mandate

 Invest in projects designed with residents

Creating new revenue streams for the future

- **Redevelop vacant buildings**
- Paid park-and-ride facilities near the border (free for Hégenheim residents)
- Extension of the **South craft zone**
- Rental of municipal equipment
- Combat vacant land and unused properties

 More resources meaning less tax pressure

Anticipate, prioritize, empower

- Create a contingency reserve fund
- **Phasing** of major projects
- “Budget & Projects” public forum to set priorities with residents
- Publish an annual financial report
- Multi-year planning
- 10-year outlook (development of the centre, climate, energy, mobility)

What is an Advisory Council ?

It is an assembly of representatives of associations, shopkeepers and businesses, young people, seniors and district delegates, who share their views and regularly discuss with elected officials on important projects.

→ Welcoming Hégenheim

An embellished living environment, a valued heritage

Enhancing our living environment and preserving our heritage

- Launch "**Hégenheim Cœur de Ville 2040**": a consultation between residents and professionals to rethink the city centre
- Finalising the Local Urban Plan (PLU) to manage development
- Create and renovate **convivial spaces**
- Bringing buildings and businesses back to life: **tackling vacant and neglected properties**, supporting owners, using legal and fiscal levers if necessary. Develop a shopfront charter with local businesses
- Strengthen the **cleanliness** and maintenance of public spaces (fountains, roads)
- Reducing noise and odour pollution

Enhancing our built, cultural and historical heritage

- Create a heritage and cultural pedestrian route throughout Hégenheim
- Consult residents on the future of the **Alsatian house Immelin** (example: intergenerational friendly place)
- Gradually renovate vacant housing and **municipal buildings** (former nursery school, former customs office, former notary's office) to rent them out or use them for community benefit.



Safer and more responsible travel

Making travel safer

- Conduct regular road safety assessments ; act accordingly
- **Securing** the surroundings of schools and public facilities
- **Reduce speed on high-risk roads** with adapted developments and measures
- Install traffic mirrors and reinforce pedestrian crossings
- Support the development of a bypass for Hégenheim

Facilitate soft mobility

- Develop a municipal **soft mobility plan** (cycle paths, pedestrians, horse riders, etc.)
- Create park-and-ride facilities (Placette de l'Europe and Allschwil border), with paid parking for non-residents
- Work with Saint-Louis Agglomération to create a central bus line -> rue de Bâle -> new park-and-ride -> **Switzerland**
- Increase the frequency of **public transport**

Safety, prevention and peace of mind for all

Ensuring everyone's safety

- **Train a municipal public safety officer (ASVP)** - (presence, parking, incivility, etc.)
- Explore the possibility of a shared municipal police force in partnership with a neighbouring municipality
- Combating **violence against women and children** (prevention, awareness-raising, detection)
- Continue efforts to prevent illegal land occupation



Fighting burglaries

- Strengthen collaboration with the gendarmerie for an **increased visible patrols** and raise awareness of preventive actions
- Develop the "Neighbourhood Watch network" as well as an **Community-wide alert** system
- Negotiate group rates for alarm systems

Preventing and managing risks

- Update the Communal Safeguarding Plan (PCS) and inform the population
- Create a **Communal Civil Security Reserve** (trained volunteers)
- Regularly check fire safety standards in all public buildings"
- Study and implement sustainable flood prevention measures to ensure regular maintenance and cleaning of the Lertzbach riverbed
- Provide emergency accommodation for affected residents

Protecting our environment and preparing for the future

Acting together for a future sustainable

- Create an **extra-municipal commission for sustainable development** with a dedicated elected official and an environmental charter
- Launch a green participatory budget for citizen-led projects
- Inform and raise awareness (eco-gesture workshops, conferences with SLA*)

Conserve resources and reduce our impact (with ALS*)

- Manage the communal forest with a focus on resilience, without unnecessary logging
- Objective "**Everything recyclable by 2030**" during events and a responsible event charter
- Improving the **management of waste drop-off** points and Fight against illegal dumping (alert system)
- **Extend opening hours of the local green waste collection centre** in Hégenheim
- Develop and support composting initiatives and ensure good drinking water quality

Greening our environment

- Transform paved areas into cooler green spaces to reduce heatwave effects
- Create a shared orchard supporting biodiversity and local food production

Municipal energy plan

- Explore the creation of a local energy cooperative focused on photovoltaic production
- Reduce municipal energy consumption (solar panels, LED lighting, building insulation, etc.)

Your health, our top priority

Strengthening the provision of care

- Explore the creation of a **health centre** (in the old nursery school)
- Attract new **healthcare professionals** (incentives)
- Develop **teleconsultation** services
- Host mobile screening and healthcare units
- Install defibrillators in all neighbourhoods
- Strengthening cross-border cooperation in care
- Improve access to local hospital services (with local actors)

Prevention for all

- **First aid training (open to all)**
- Organise prevention initiatives and awareness events, for all generations
- Relaunch the "Heart Health Day"
- Integrate health prevention into all municipal policies (urban planning, environment, school, food, etc.)

Empowering our children to succeed

Learning in good conditions


- Guarantee a place in the school canteen for every student
- Offer seasonal and locally sourced fruit in schools
- Develop appropriate digital equipment in line with national education standards
- Strengthening the **fight against harassment**
- Supporting school projects and the parents' association
- Weekly homework support sessions (intergenerational volunteering)
- **End-of-year** ceremony in primary school
- Awards for deserving students

Flourishing, playing, growing

- Creating inclusive playgrounds
- Maintain support for school sports and access to adapted facilities (swimming pool, stadium, etc.)
- Create an **indoor space dedicated to teens** (hobbies, music, games)
- Develop the **multi-sports** area
- Set up a career mentoring programme for young people with local professionals

Becoming engaged citizens

- Create a Municipal Youth Council, including a study visit to national institutions (Paris)
- Official voter card ceremony at age 18
- Provide **first aid** training for all schoolchildren and mental health first aid support for teenagers

• Create a Civic Responsibility Passport for young people:

to encourage civic engagement and community involvement, with Actions in solidarity, civic, memorial and environmental issues, Organise dedicated "Discovery Days" of institutions and Alsatian heritage

Aging well, together

Strengthening the links and the place of seniors

- Create a **Council of Elders**
- Sustaining and developing an **offer a wide range of adapted activities**, with new workshops (road safety workshops, raising awareness of scams and abuses, basic computer training, etc.)
- Improve facilities at the Steblé meeting place (meeting place)
- Set up intergenerational mentoring programme to watch over and break isolation (calls, visits, etc.)

Making everyday life easier

- Create a permanent office to support home care services
- Develop **housing adapted to seniors**
- Supporting on-demand transport

Supporting families

A real service for families

- Create a Municipal Youth & Families Department

Adapted childcare solutions

- Develop childcare solutions with extended or flexible hours
- Organise a welcome morning for newly registered families
- Adjust nursery places according to demand

Accessible housing for all

- Develop affordable housing **for young people and families** (e.g. rehabilitation of the old customs house)
- Integrate **affordable housing** into all new development projects (Local Urban Plan – PLU)

Useful , targeted and fair aid

- Help all children take part in sports and cultural activities (Means-tested support paid directly to local associations, aid paid directly to local associations)
- Offer a fruit tree for each birth

Bringing solidarity to life

- Support people in vulnerable situations and their caregivers (financial, fuel poverty, illness, etc.)
- Strengthen our commitment to solidarity initiatives (create an event in support of sick children)
- Make Hégenheim an **"Ambassador Town"** for organ donation

Support local shops, artisans and businesses

Include their representatives in local decision-making

- Integrate their representatives into the **Municipal Advisory Council**

Supporting local economic activity

- **Revitalise the weekly market** (more exhibitors, regular events, friendly space to eat on site)
- Support the introduction of local shopping vouchers
- Involving shopkeepers in major municipal events in order to generate economic benefits

Increase their visibility and enhance their value

- Support the organization of a **local Business Open Day**
- Develop promotional initiatives (profiles, annual awards, enhanced communication)

Strengthening economic attractiveness

- Develop an economic attractiveness strategy for the installation of local shops
- Set up a **one-stop shop** in the town hall to support entrepreneurs in their efforts
- Develop the South Craft Zone
- Require commercial premises in new town centre developments (PLU)

Keep Hégenheim lively all year round

Strengthening welcome, sharing and conviviality

- Organise welcome events for new residents
- Encourage community gatherings (Neighbours' Day, etc.), the creation of a **world festival to celebrate diversity**
- Organise weekly **summer events** in partnership with merchants and associations
- Supporting the development of the Käsnapferfascht and the outdoor **Christmas market**
- Maintain and strengthen the town twinning with Morcenx-la-Nouvelle

Supporting associations and valuing their volunteers

- Explore the creation of a "House of Associations"
- Maintain and strengthen subsidies (fair and transparent criteria)
- Ensure suitable and practical premises
- Establish an **annual Associations Day**
- Communicate more about associations and their events
- Recognise **outstanding volunteers** at an annual ceremony



Sport and culture bring people together all year round.

Promoting sport for all

- Create a **Municipal Sports Office** to coordinate sports activities and inform residents
- Develop the **multi-sports area** (e.g. pump track, pétanque courts, etc.)
- Regularly maintain the Vita Course and municipal sports facilities
- Offer monthly **sports activities open to all** on the Vita Course and in the multi-sports area
- **Recognise outstanding athletes (annual award ceremony)**

Promoting Culture

Developing flagship actions

- Setting up an **annual cultural programme** (existing and new events)
- Organise a **music festival** with open stages
- Setting up an **open-air summer photo exhibition**
- Create a welcoming **cultural space** (e.g. library, games library, literary café)
- Explore the introduction of an "Orchestra at School" programme
- Supporting cultural initiatives

Valuing local identities

- Encourage the Alsatian language and culture
- Maintain and strengthen commemorative ceremonies

Animal welfare

- Encourage **responsible behaviour** (identification, sterilisation, respect for public spaces)
- Raise awareness about respect for animals and biodiversity
- Support animal protection associations
- Promote **biodiversity** (corridors, green spaces, habitats, etc.)
- Fight **invasive species** (Asian hornet, Japanese beetle, etc.) with proportionate and effective measures
